



WSOP \$10,000 MAIN EVENT QUALIFIER

2/26/09 – 2/24/10



We are extremely excited to announce our brand new WSOP 10k Qualifier Series that will culminate with a 256 player Head's Up tournament on February 27th, 2010! The event will have qualifying starting with the point's events on Thursday, February 26th, 2009 and running through Wednesday, February 25th, 2010.

What are you playing for?

- A Guaranteed \$2,500 WSOP seat for the 2010 World Series of Poker and \$500 travel, which can increase into a WSOP \$10,000 Main Event seat at the '10 WSOP.

How do you win?

- To win the \$2,500 WSOP Seat, just defeat 8 players in a Head's Up format and be the title holder of "Head's Up Champion of All In Free Poker", out of 256 of our best players.
- The Head's Up Champion will then play Sandy in a head's up match.
 - o Defeat Sandy and instead of the \$2,500 seat, you'll win a \$5,000 WSOP seat & \$500 for travel
 - o You'll play Bryan next regardless of your outcome against Sandy
 - If you beat Sandy, you will now have won a guaranteed \$5,000 WSOP seat & \$500 for travel, which can turn into a \$10,000 WSOP Main Event seat.
 - If you lose to Sandy, you will still play Bryan; and you can earn the \$5,000 WSOP seat & \$500 for travel by beating Bryan. The person cannot lose the \$2,500 seat, even if they lose both matches to Sandy & Bryan, it is guaranteed.
 - o If you are Head's Up champion and you beat Sandy AND Bryan in the resulting Head's Up matches, you will win the \$10k WSOP Main Event seat as the final prize!!
- But if you want to be the best and play the best in the biggest event, you gotta beat the best in our league AND beat both the bosses to do it!

How do you qualify?

- The top 150 in the cumulative final standings from the seasons ending on: 5/13/09; 7/29/09; 10/14/09; & 1/6/10 will make the finals. If any point changes are placed into effect during that span, all seasons will be recalculated for purposes of this top 150 (but won't affect the actual seasons individually). 10 randomly drawn participants from the final on 2/27/09 – 3/3/09 that did the \$100 chip up will make it in. The remaining 96 spots will be filled through the following: Bar Exemptions, approx. 45-50 (1 per night that the location is a WSOP Qualifier); Top 10 in total spending outside the 150 spots already filled; Top 10 in Games Played outside the top 150 already filled; Top 10 in wins outside the 150 spots already filled; reserve of remainder for growth of locations, as well as other qualifier parameters, including the last minute qualifying dates of 1/7/10 – 2/24/10.

Where & when will this happen?

- The final event will be played in a one or multiple of our bars on Saturday, February 27th & Sunday, February 28th, 2010. On Friday night, February 26th, we will hold the mandatory registration/seeding party at one of our bars, as we as a big kickoff party. The final list of players will be announced on Thursday, February 25th, with constant updates from January 7th to the end of qualifying on February 24th, so you can plan for the event accordingly.

What's the format for the event?

- As we stated before, this will be a Head's Up event. For those that haven't played a head's up event before, all 256 players will be seeded from 1-256 and broken into four 64 player regions at the seeding party on the preceding Friday night. You then play a person heads up until one person wins all the chips. Then, the winner plays the winner of the bracket directly above or below them, and so on until there is just one person left standing. All players will start with the same amount of chips, with no extra chip options. Players will start with 100 big blinds for each round.

We look forward to another great season and another great final at the isle in February!
