Player Code of Conduct

All players have a duty to look out for the welfare & best interest of the league. Failure to do so can result in a ban from future play in the league. This league is designed to provide a fun & friendly social outlet to also work on your poker game. The options to tip the dealer, re-enter/re-tip, and purchasing food & beverage from the sponsor locations are all optional; however, without the support of the players in the league in these options, events will cease to exist, taking away your outlet for fun & skill building.

The following guidelines will help you to know what the code of conduct and behavior is. While we thank you for playing in the league, remember that is a privilege to play with All In Free Poker, not a right.

1. Promoting the league and attracting new players is paramount to continue growth and availability to outlets to play that are near your home and/or work.
2. Discouraging players from tipping and/or re-entering & re-tipping is not allowed. Dealers are volunteers there on their own time to help you have an outstanding experience. To attempt to block them from the making the optional initial tips or re-entry tips, that ultimately, they are there to earn, is an attempt to undo the quality of the league and can result in a ban of the offending player.
3. Making up information about how the business is run, where money goes or trying to inform other players, is detrimental to the league and nothing more than petty gossip. All In Free Poker is a for profit business. We offer robust prizes and opportunities to you, the player. As such, you should want us to succeed and profit in business, for if we do not, you will not have an outlet to play. You have chosen to play with All In Free Poker due to our professionalism, top-of-the-line prizes and locations, friendly atmosphere and superior offerings to other leagues out there. To attempt to undermine that is to undermine you. Do you want people to go to your place of employment and undermine it, resulting in lower wages for you? Obviously not. All In Free Poker is not a major corporation or conglomerate, it is a small local business owned by Bryan Oulton & Sandy Swartzbaugh; we both have families to support and this is what we do full-time, this isn't a second job. We are in the office in Pompano Beach 5 days per week, working hard to add locations, sponsors and prizes to continue to make the league the best offering in the market. Players who are found to be attempting to undermine the ability of the league to make money can be banned.
4. Rude behavior towards other players is completely unacceptable. Again, this is a fun & friendly social league that offers great prizes. Treat others as you would wish to be treated. Players who berate others, try to drive others away, or are just boorish towards other players, dealers or the staff of locations can be banned. You are a guest of the league and the location. It is a privilege to play with All In Free Poker, not a right.
5. There is one dealer to a table. When players constantly interfere with the dealer's ability to run the game, it only slows down the game and aggravates others. If you see an error, quickly point it out, but allow the dealer to run the game. Constant attempts to inform on what a pot amount should be, what a rule is, etc are disruptive. Players who consistently nag and slow games could be banned.

This league is for fun; please enjoy it for that and continue to help us grow and offer more to you, the player. You're only helping yourself when you do!
